WATER POLICY

1. Introduction

Providing clean water is the fundamental right of each living species and is an essential part of life. Therefore, the Women University of Azad Jammu and Kashmir Bagh (WUAJ&K) has a leading priority to provide drinking water to all community members, guests, visitors, etc.

2. <u>Scope</u>

These water policies shall apply to all water-related activities of WUAJK, including all the external members involved.

3. Policy Guidelines

The WUAJK Bagh shall:

- (i) Ensure the provision of clean drinking water to the WUAJK community and visitors, guests, etc.
- (ii) WUAJK will collaborate with regional, state, and national organizations (government and non-government) to improve water resource management.
- (iii) Initiate training and awareness workshops to promote the safe use of water resources.
- (iv) Promote research related to water quality and water preservation.
- (v) Engage the faculty, staff, and students in water conservation activities on campus and in the local community.
- (vi) Encourage the WUAJK community to report the wastage of water on campus timely.
- (vii) Incorporate courses in academic programs related to water conservation.

(viii) Ensure possible wastewater reuse, and prevent polluted water from entering the drinking water system.

4. <u>Report on Violation</u>

All WUAJ&K community members must report to the authorities concerned, without fear, any incident where known facts indicate a possibility of a policy violation.

5. <u>Revision of Policy</u>

Revisions to these policies will be made as and when necessary.
