



Public resources (lifelong learning)

At the Women University of Azad Jammu and Kashmir Bagh, we are committed to promoting lifelong learning by providing free access to educational resources for the broader community. The University aims to empower individuals beyond our students, ensuring that education remains accessible to all, regardless of their formal academic status. It includes the provision of free courses and training workshops (open for all females), free access to campus facilities, and free access to online resources, as described below:

1. Free Courses/ Training workshops

Women University of Azad Jammu & Kashmir regularly organizes free courses, training workshops, and seminars to foster lifelong learning and skill development. These programs are designed to enhance educational and professional opportunities, particularly for women in the community. Public access is provided to many of these events, ensuring that female participants from various backgrounds can benefit from the university's resources and gain valuable knowledge and skills. This initiative reflects our dedication to supporting lifelong learning and community engagement through open access to education.

In this reporting period, the following free courses and seminars were organized:

a) Model Lesson Plan

This initiative involved private school and college teachers who trained using a model lesson plan. Certificates were awarded to those who performed well in the post-training evaluation, which assessed their performance after completing the program. This initiative is designed to benefit the participating teachers and enhance their teaching practices in the classroom. As a result, the improved instructional methods will be disseminated throughout the district, contributing to better regional educational outcomes. (Evidence in ANNEX. I)







b) Seminar on Diagnosis and Treatment of Cancer

In response to the increasing number of cancer cases reported in the district in recent years, a "Seminar on Diagnosis and Treatment of Cancer" was organized. This training workshop addressed the growing concern by providing participants with essential knowledge and skills related to cancer prevention, diagnosis, and treatment. The seminar included: (Evidence in ANNEX. II)

Educational Sessions: Expert speakers (Dr. Sami-Ullah Khan, Associate Professor; Dr. Tahira Batool, Assistant Professor; Dr. Sadia Mumtaz, Assistant Professor) provided insights into the latest cancer diagnosis and treatment advancements, covering various types of cancer and emerging therapeutic approaches.

Protective Measures: Participants were trained to use protective measures, particularly about food safety and hygiene, to reduce potential cancer risks associated with dietary factors.

Practical Training: Hands-on sessions were conducted to demonstrate effective early detection and prevention techniques, including lifestyle modifications and screening practices.

Interactive Discussions: Open forums allowed healthcare professionals, researchers, and participants to exchange experiences and strategies, fostering a collaborative approach to tackling cancer-related challenges.

This workshop was designed to equip participants with practical skills and knowledge and raise awareness about cancer prevention and treatment. The initiative aims to improve community health by disseminating critical information and practices to improve the district's cancer outcomes.

2. Free Access to Campus Facilities

The Women University of Azad Jammu & Kashmir extends free access to the following campus facilities to female students from surrounding private schools and colleges. (Evidence in Annex. III)







- a) **Computer Labs:** These are open to female students from neighboring schools and colleges and provide access to technology and academic resources.
- b) **Sports Facilities:** These are available to female students from the local community and promote physical fitness and recreational activities.
- c) **Library:** This is free and accessible to female students from nearby institutions. It offers various educational materials and resources for lifelong learning.
- d) **Internet and Workspace:** Dedicated internet access and workspace are provided for female students interested in freelancing and online jobs, enabling them to pursue digital work opportunities.

3. Free Access to Online Resources

Women University of Azad Jammu & Kashmir offers essential online resources to support ongoing education and research (Evidence in Annex. IV)

- a) Free Online Courses: We collaborate with platforms such as Coursera and Google Cloud to provide free access to various online courses. This opportunity is available to our students and colleges throughout the district, facilitating skill development and knowledge enhancement for learners across multiple disciplines.
- b) Institutional Repository: Our institutional repository on the university website provides access to the university's research output. This repository allows students, researchers, and the public to explore and utilize our institution's latest academic research and publications.

FREE ACCESS TO UNIVERSITY RESOURCES FOR THE COMMUNITY

1. Introduction

This policy provides a guide to optimize the use of Women University of Azad Jammu and Kashmir (WUAJ&K) Bagh facilities by students, faculty, staff, and community members. The University reserves the right to regulate the use of its property. The University intends to fulfill its teaching, research, and community engagement mission. Therefore, to avoid disrupting the normal activities needed to carry out its mission, the University shall regulate access to university facilities.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all WUAJ&K Bagh facilities (including buildings, grounds, and spaces owned or monitored by the University), which extends to members of the academic community, such as guests of the University and members of the general public, lawfully present on university premises.

3. Policy Guidelines/ Implementation Procedure

Subject to University uses and reasonable time, place, and manner restrictions, and university facilities may be made available on a first-come, first-served basis in the following order of priority: students, employees, and community members.

The WUAJ&K Bagh may provide the following facilities to those who are not studying in the University (only females), subject to no disruption of the normal activities of the University.

- a) Free access to the university library
- b) Computer labs
- c) Space facilities for sports activities







A central library in the university campus has been established with the collaboration of Higher Education Commission (HEC). The contributions.

The library has more than 10,000 collections of books, magazines, periodicals, research papers and research journals. The collection is available in different languages and forms like, CDs, DVDs, microfilms, video and audio cassettes and manuscripts. The library has 65,000 ebooks, 32 research journals locally and internationally having monthly bi-monthly quarterly and annually. Famous national and local newspaper are on daily basis. The library has beautiful and well decorated room in the building. There is a reading hall with the seating capacity of approximately 100 readers. The library has Internet facility for online access of the material. It has a computerized "OPAC" catalogue for searching material.

Books Accumulation: Efforts are being made to extend the volume of library. The Vice Chancellor has also approached different universities and donors for the donation of books for library. So far, the university has successfully got the grant of Rs.2.00 million for the initial establishment of library. The library provides the facility of lending, indoor reading, photocopy, Internet facility and orientation services. The university has launched a new web based Library Management System (LMS) in colloboration with PASTIC to provide access to updated
