



## **Public Resources (Lifelong Learning)**

The Women University of Azad Jammu and Kashmir, Bagh, is committed to community engagement by providing access to educational resources even for individuals not enrolled at the university. Among these, a few examples are described below:

### **First Women Software Technology Park**

The First Women Software Technology Park of Pakistan, established with the support of the Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB), is a pioneering initiative to empower women in the field of information technology. The Park offers state-of-the-art infrastructure, high-speed connectivity, and a collaborative environment that enables women to pursue innovation, entrepreneurship, and professional skill development. It also provides mentorship, training programs, and business support services to encourage women-led startups and enhance their contribution to the digital economy. ### **Free Online Institutional Repository**

The University has developed a Free Online Institutional Repository to promote open access to knowledge. This digital platform offers the community free access to theses, dissertations, research papers, and other scholarly materials, enabling researchers, students, and the general public to explore and benefit from the research conducted at the University. A central library in the university campus has been established with the collaboration of Higher Education Commission (HEC). The contributions.

The library has more than 10,000 collections of books, magazines, periodicals, research papers and research journals. The collection is available in different languages and forms like, CDs, DVDs, microfilms, video and audio cassettes and manuscripts. The library has 65,000 ebooks, 32 research journals locally and internationally having monthly bi-monthly quarterly and annually. Famous national and local newspaper are on daily basis. The library has beautiful and well decorated room in the building. There is a reading hall with the seating capacity of approximately 100 readers. The library has Internet facility for online access of the material. It has a computerized "OPAC" catalogue for searching material.

**Books Accumulation:** Efforts are being made to extend the volume of library. The Vice Chancellor has also approached different universities and donors for the donation of books for library. So far, the university has successfully got the grant of Rs.2.00 million for the initial establishment of library. The library provides the facility of lending, indoor reading, photocopy, Internet facility and orientation services. The university has launched a new web based Library Management System (LMS) in collaboration with PASTIC to provide access to updated [Online Public Access Catalogue \(OPAC\)](#)
